3D Fusion:

- 1. Reconstruct two thin data sets—one of tibial tubericals and one of trochlear grooves
- 2. Open AQNet
- 3. Select appropriate patient
- 4. From series list, select both data sets by holding down the CTRL key
- 5. Click Muti Data
- 6. Click fusion from upper left screen
- 7. Work from upper right viewport—select \mathbf{F} (feet) from viewport toolbar
- 8. Ensure Raysum is selected on both data sets located bottom toolbar of right upper viewport

- 9. Adjust window and level on both images
- 10. Use left upper viewport to adjust data placement
