- 1. Please see Madison Pediatric Rotation Requirements on Canvas website.
- 2. Two weeks of outpatient and two weeks of inpatient.
- 3. Duty Hours must average less than 80 hours/week for working in the clinic or hospital ONLY. This **DOES NOT** include study time.
- Outpatient clinic hours generally run from 8:00 am 5:00 pm with no night or weekend responsibilities. Please arrive at 7:50 am even if the schedule does not show a patient at 8:00 am as schedules can change overnight.
- Inpatient hours generally run from 8:00 am 5:00 pm <u>NOT</u> including pre-rounding or call, both of which are crucial and required.
- 6. Call is every 3rd night when on in-patient service including weekends.
- 7. Call is Monday-Friday 5:00 pm-11:00 pm // Saturday & Sunday 8:00 am-11:00 pm
- 8. No call the night prior to the exam.
- 9. Written work requirements-you are required to do 1 formal write-up either an H&P or a consult note during your entire 12 weeks of the CALC Block. If you choose to do this when you are on the Pediatric portion of your experience, please email them to Dr. Weber at LSWEBER@GUNDERSENHEALTH.ORG (the email address is not case sensitive) no later than 8 am of the 4th Tuesday of the Pediatric portion of your rotation. This way Dr. Weber will be able to grade it and get the feedback to you prior to completing your time in Pediatrics.
- 10. Didactic Sessions-REQUIRED
 - a. Student Didactic Sessions/Block Learning Time (BLT): See schedule for dates/times
 - Pediatric Department Lectures: 2nd Thursday of the month at 8 am (Pediatric Education Hour) and 4th Thursday of the month at 7 am (Pediatric Radiology Conference)
- Other Conferences <u>NOT</u> required (you can attend when work is done in the clinic and on inpatient)
