t Scheduling	Mention the "Welcome to Medicare Visit" to your Gundersen scheduler.	Mention the "Medicare Annual Wellness Visit" to your Gundersen scheduler. Ask for an additional disease management appointment if you have new or existing health	Your disease management visit can be scheduled before or after your Medicare Annual Wellness Visit. These are two separate appointments.
